## Below is a list of questions that you may want to answer in your personal statement.

- > Why you have chosen the course you have listed?
- ➤ What interests you about the chosen subject?
- ➤ How have you developed your subject interest outside of your school studies? Have you read any relevant books or articles, attended lectures or courses? How did these activities inform your choice of course?
- ➤ What are the 'big' issues in the subject(s) you have applied for, or what do you find most interesting about the?
- ➤ Which jobs, paid work or placements have you undertaken, and what have you learnt from them? Did these experiences influence your choices of degree and why?
- ➤ What are your social, sport and leisure activities (although these are not as important as your academic capabilities)?
- ➤ Have you held any **positions of responsibility** in your school?
- ➤ Have you attended any schemes or activities at any university (Summer Schools, specific courses etc.)?
- ➤ Have you won or applied for any sponsorship or placements?
- ➤ Emphasize any **skills** you have gained (eg. Communication/IT/decision making)
- ➤ What are you career plans for when you graduate from university?
- ➤ What are your future plans?
